To find McDonald's, exit I-494 to the west on Valley Creek Rd., go 1 block, turn left (So.) on Wier Dr., and watch for "Golden Arches". Participant's meeting at 9:45, depart at 10:00 am. Total distance will be about 240 miles. We will travel along the shores of the Mississippi River, and through a few of the hills along the river. Leaves should still be on the trees as we head south.

Destination 1: Lark Toy Store and Museum in Kellogg, Mn. One of the world's 10 largest toy stores. Thousands of toys, hand-carved carousel (\$2 to ride), spectacular mini-golf (\$6 for 18 holes), toy museum, café, llamas. No fee for store and museum. We'll be there roughly 11:30 to 12:30. Then we cross the Mississippi in Winona, and drive through some of the hills on the Wisconsin side of the river.

Admission \$10 Adults, \$8 Seniors, \$5 for 6 to 17 years old (under 5 free). We'll be there roughly 1:00 to 2:30 pm. Then a trip back along WI 35 through many small, picturesque river towns.
