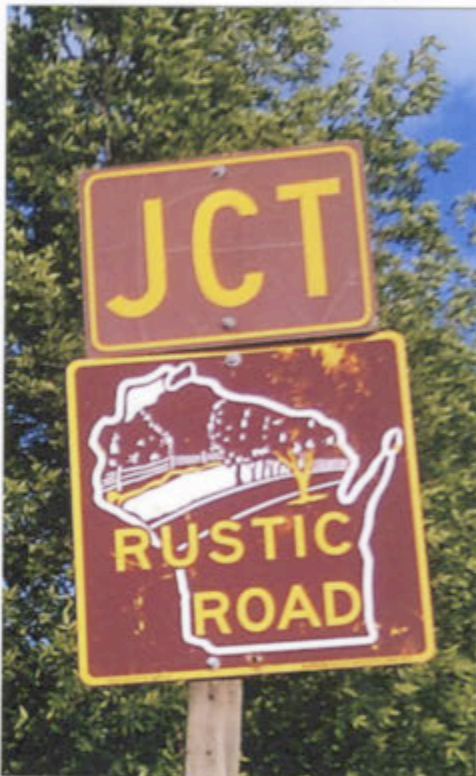


Our annual fall cruise will take place on Saturday, October 15, 2022. Register and sign waivers and get Route Instructions at 10:00 am, with departure at 10:30 am. Register in the lot of the McDonald's at 14545 60th Street North, Oak Park Heights, which is the south frontage road for Mn Hwy 36 near Stillwater, about a mile to the west of the St. Croix River Crossing Bridge. Parking also should be available at the Taco Bell immediately west of the McDonald's. McDonald's is open for dining inside or drive-thru for those wanting a quick breakfast, while Taco Bell is still drive-thru only. The cruise is open to all cars and individuals, and doesn't require a Corvette or membership in the club. This year we're asking for a \$5 per car donation to offset costs of putting on the event. We'll be in Washington County of Minnesota, and Pierce and St. Croix Counties of Wisconsin.

Our route will be just under 90 miles total, and include many scenic drives including two of Wisconsin's designated "Rustic Roads" that we haven't been on before. We'll have a brief rest stop about 1:15 midway through the cruise where snacks and rest rooms will be available, and later a half-hour visit to the Carpenter St. Croix Valley Nature Center on St. Croix Trail south of Afton, Mn, with up to 14 varieties of apples in their "Apple Shack" plus perhaps cider, apple brats, and other items available in addition to the trails and interpretive nature center. No cost for admission. We'll finish the Cruise at the Muddy Cow Bar and Grille in Oak Park Heights, about a mile west of the starting point, about 1:30, where they have a full selection of menu items from burgers to steaks, and always free cheese balls plus 2 for 1 pizzas and beer.



Hope you'll be able to join us for a fun drive on some enjoyable roads and an interesting stop. By October 15th the trees should be in full color, too.
