Sign waivers, get Route Directions and make a donation of \$5 to cover expenses of the Cruise near the McDonald's at 3990 12th Ave. E, Shakopee, Mn., just SE of Canterbury Park, on the west side of Canterbury Rd., and just north of Hwy 169. Waivers at 8:30 am, entrants meeting at 8:45, and depart at 9:00 am.

We'll drive on some scenic roads viewing the fall colors past Mystic Lake Casino, through Prior Lake, through New Prague (with a short Rest Stop), and plan to arrive at the Candy Store by about 10:30. Note-the Candy Store takes cash and checks, but no credit cards, but does have ATMs inside. Some great photo ops inside and outside the Candy Store as well. Lots of apple products available at the Candy Store, but we may also stop briefly at an orchard in the area. Then we'll return on Hwy 169 to our end point at the Muddy Cow (1244 Canterbury Rd., Shakopee), just across the parking lot from our starting point, by 1:00 pm. The total Cruise should be roughly 90 miles. Muddy Cow is a sports bar with great appetizers, burgers, and wraps, plus always "Two for One" on pizzas and beer. The Cruise is open to everyone, with no requirement for club membership or make of vehicle.
